Assistance for Bars/Restaurants

Pursuant to [City Code 10-340](#) Businesses that have a retail sale by drink license can deliver alcoholic beverages. Must be in the closed, original package or container. Deliveries cannot be received by a person under 21 and must be made during the hours allowed under the license. Pursuant to [City Code 10-102](#), certain licensees can also sell alcoholic beverage in the original package on the licensed premises. [KCMO Water Services](#) – Suspended water shut-offs for nonpayment
[Evergy](#) (Electricity) - Suspended disconnects for nonpayment, extended payment options, reduced reconnect fees, and no late fees until May 1 (residential and small business customers)
[Spire](#) (Natural Gas) – Suspended disconnects and late fees until May 1, 2020

Internet Access

[Spectrum](#) – Suspended service terminations for 60 days, waiving late fees for residential and small business customers, partnering with school districts, and opening wi-fi hotspots for public use
